


# MONTANA MUSIC SUMMIT

## INCEPTION

The long-running Music Summit conference series descends on Missoula, MT for the inaugural Montana Music Summit, co-hosted by the University of Montana's Entertainment Management program. Started by veteran music industry executives with deep relationships in the professional recording community, past Music Summit events have featured emerging artist showcases, top-tier industry panels, music education seminars, VIP events and an outdoor music festival.

## PURPOSE

This two-day conference brings together artists, entertainment executives, lifestyle brands, technology professionals, college students, entrepreneurs and visionaries to present, educate and share ideas that are facing the evolving entertainment landscape. The event is an opportunity for individuals from diverse backgrounds to engage in an environment that's conducive to sharing information and creative collaborations. In addition, the conference has established itself as a curator of emerging talent. Past showcasing artists have become successful recording artists, with their first exposure to music companies at Music Summit events.

Music Summit participants include: record company executives from major and indie labels, music producers, recording artists, songwriters, booking agents, club promoters, talent managers, entertainment attorneys, tech entrepreneurs and music publishers.
